

# Toronto Rugby – 2016 Calendar & League Information

#### 1 a. Invoices - Commitment to League Play:

The TR invoices will be sent based on the teams entered into league play in 2015 plus new declared teams. If a team is entered into league play and pulls out after the drop dead date the club will be liable for the 2nd half dues, immediately (Senior Dues \$250, U16/U18.U20 \$125).

1st ½ payment for senior dues Mar 25th

2nd ½ payment for senior dues July 15th

Payment for junior teams: May 27th

#### NOTES:

- 1. The C Division teams do not have to commit to be full schedule. The team can commit to 4 games, 6 games etc. however that commitment, once made will be enforced.
- 2. Payment must be received by the deadline to be eligible for entry into league play.
- No changes will be made, approved or allowed to the junior schedule after it is released. If you need a date switched or moved, get it approved by the game director before that date.
- 4. If you cannot declare a junior team by the declaration date and end up getting the numbers together after that date, the game director may be able to accommodate the team.
- 5. THE REVISED FEE TO BE PAID AFTER THE DECLARATION DATE IS \$175. The entire schedule WILL NOT be disrupted.

# 2. Other Competitions Which Will Affect League Play:

CRC U-19 Men/ U-20 Women- July 13-19, RO Magnificent 7's July 21-24, Ontario Summer Games August 11-14. Senior Women and Junior Nationals- August 15-21, RO Junior Cup Day-Aug 28

#### 3. Registrations:

All clubs must have enough registered players (15 per team for seniors, 18 per team for juniors) to meet the commitments made for the entry of teams into league play.

Registration deadline for seniors Wednesday before the 1st League game 20th

Registration deadline for juniors Wednesday before the 1st League game (Jun 3rd, 10th, 17th).

A fine of \$150 will be levied to a club for not having the minimum number of registered players by the Wednesday before the scheduled league game. This fine will continue to apply (each week) until the club meets the minimum registration level.

#### 4. Defaults:

All teams in league play will be assessed and billed a fee of \$150 per default PLUS THE REFERE'S match fee (if they are not properly notified by the Thursday 9 pm deadline) which will be due immediately upon receipt of the invoice.

Since the clubs have sufficient time to review the schedule and have the ability at the lower levels to make less than a full schedule commitment, ALL DEFAULTS WILL BE ENFORCED. Once the club commits to games for a team, it must meet the commitment. Teams with defaults are not eligible for play offs.
